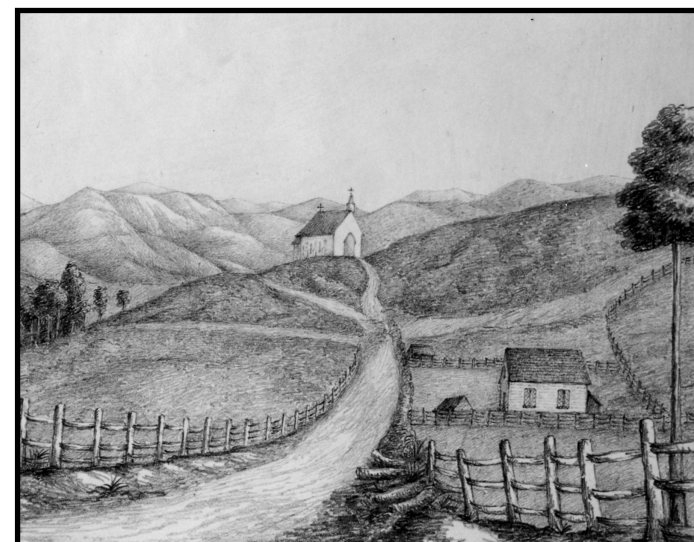

## ABOUT THE COLLECTION

The Nelson Provincial Museum's art collection includes material collected by Nelson Institute & Museum, Nelson Historical Society, Dr F.A. Bett and The Nelson Provincial Museum.

Currently there are approximately 750 original works in the collection including 410 watercolours, 120 oils, 155 dry media works.

## ARTISTS REPRESENTED

Many of the artists represented lived and worked in the Nelson region. There are significant numbers of landscapes of the Nelson/Tasman region, views of Nelson City dating from the 1850's, and botanical illustrations.

### Included are large collections of works by:

- **Nina Jones (1871-1926)**

A prolific painter, her watercolours make up a significant portion of the Museum's collection and include 200 botanical illustrations and 40 landscapes.

- **Sarah Greenwood (1809-1889)**

A well-known settler in Motueka, she drew and painted landscapes of the Motueka district, neighbours' houses, and early Nelson.

- **Arthur Shuckburgh Collyns (1832-1911)**

Ink and pencil drawings of landscapes and houses mainly in Motueka, Riwaka, Brooklyn.
